York County Fire and Life Safety Responds to House Fire in Quail Hollow Subdivision, Grafton area of York County

At approximately 11:30 p.m. on May 1, 2025, personnel from the York County Department of Fire and Life Safety were dispatched to the report of a “residential structure fire” in the 100 block of Cavalier Drive in the Quail Hollow subdivision, which is in the Grafton area of York County. Upon arrival, fire and rescue units observed heavy fire and smoke conditions at the residence. The two occupants had exited the structure prior to the arrival of Fire and Life Safety units. However, they required medical treatment and were transported to Bon Secours Mary Immaculate Hospital with a non-life threatening conditions.

Firefighting crews quickly located the fire and it was under control shortly after arrival. There were no firefighter injuries. The residence sustained significant damage.

The specific cause is under investigation.
