**York County Fire and Life Safety Responds to Residential
Structure Fire in Northern York**

At approximately 5:35 p.m. this evening, personnel from the York County Department of Fire and Life Safety were dispatched to the report of an apartment fire in the 100 block of Roscoe Crossing, which is the Arbors at Town Park community.

Upon arrival, fire and rescue units observed smoke and flames coming from a third floor balcony. The fire was quickly extinguished and did not spread to the interior of the building. Damages were limited to the balcony, with minor damage to the balcony below it on the second floor.

Because the fire was limited to the exterior of the building, no evacuations were ordered. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters.

James City County Fire Department and Williamsburg Fire Department provided mutual aid assistance.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
