York County Department of Fire and Life Safety Responded to Residential Fire in Northern York

Fire and Life Safety personnel responded to a fire in a home in the 100 block of Low Ridge Road in the northern portion of York County at approximately 9:55 p.m. on Tuesday, November 11. Upon arrival, Fire and Life Safety personnel encountered smoke coming from home. The fire was located in the kitchen and was quickly extinguished. Crews ventilated the home to clear the remaining smoke.

The home's occupant had safely exited the building prior to the arrival of Fire and Life Safety personnel. The occupant was able to return to their home once ventilation was complete.

There were no civilian or firefighter injuries.
