**York County Fire and Life Safety Responds After Vehicle Hits Building in Grafton Area**

At approximately 9:00 a.m. this morning, York County Fire and Life Safety personnel were dispatched to the 4700 block of George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17) for a report of a vehicle that had struck a building. Upon arrival, first responders found a mid-size SUV that had collided with a commercial structure, entering a portion of the building that houses M.D. Express urgent care.

Building occupants had evacuated prior to the arrival of Fire and Life Safety personnel. Crews secured power to the damaged portion of the building, allowing the other businesses at that location to continue normal operations.

The vehicle's driver, the sole occupant, was evaluated at the scene and was not injured. No injuries were reported among the building's occupants.

The cause of the incident is under investigation, and the structure is being evaluated by the York County Building Official and Fire Marshals.
